The crime and calls for service information was provided by the crime analysis/planning units for each agency, and was compiled by the Tempe Police Department Strategic Planning, Analysis & Research Center. The report was based on FBI Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) criteria, which are not equivalent to Arizona Revised Statute (ARS) statistics. Thus, the data cannot be compared directly with ARS reports. Under the UCR hierarchy rule only the most severe offense of an incident would be counted. For example, a burglary offense would only counted if the burglary was the most severe offense committed in the incident. The calls for service table includes dispatched/callback calls only. Arizona Department of Commerce official population estimates were used. Any incidents that had missing or incorrect information may not be properly depicted in this report.
