



MEETING MINUTES, December 9, 2009

- 41 members and non-members in attendance
- 8:00 AM: Attendees began arriving for networking and breakfast
- 9:00 AM: Aimee Currey, AACA President introduced Chief Alan Rodbell. Chief Rodbell spoke about the success of the recent IACA/AACA Joint Training Conference and the good work completed by Mary Kirkwood, Conference Chair. Chief Rodbell highlighted the perseverance and exceptional quality of work Mary exhibits at the office and in her role with the conference. Chief Rodbell expressed his gratitude for hosting the conference in Scottsdale and how impressed he was by the 300 attendees who registered despite severe budget cuts at agencies all over the country.
- 9:30 AM: Aimee Currey began the “Year in Review 2009” presentation.
 - Administrative Business began with an announcement by Debbie MacKenzie, AACA Secretary, of the election results. The 2010-2011 new Executive board members were voted in unanimously and were introduced:
 - President is Doug Smith, Avondale PD
 - Vice President is Mike Winslow, Scottsdale PD
 - Treasurer is Bryan Hill, Glendale PD
 - Secretary is Janet Johnson, Chandler PD.
 - The 2010-11 board members may begin some preliminary meetings among themselves now and will officially take over at the conclusion of the February 17, 2010, AACA quarterly meeting.
 - Susan Barbaro, Yavapai County, will remain the Member at Large to assist with the transition between the two boards. Her term ends in May 2010 and between February and May 2010, the new Board will select a new Member at Large.
 - The Treasurer’s Report was provided by AACA President Aimee Currey, in Treasurer Kristen Lottman’s absence. The Association is expecting approximately \$10,000 as a result of our participation in the Joint Training Conference. This will be added to our current balances of \$3,528 in our checking account and \$5,268 in our conference fund account. We can expect our conference check from IACA in January. The Goodsearch profit of \$150 was also announced.
 - An announcement was made about our upcoming quarterly meeting on February 17th at Target in Chandler. Subject is loss prevention techniques and intelligence analysis, in addition to information on Target’s new forensics crime lab.
 - An announcement was made on the upcoming “Internet Resources” class on January 27th in Avondale. RSVPs are being taken now.
 - Mary Kirkwood, Scottsdale PD, provided a review of the Joint Training Conference.
 - Aimee Currey concluded her presentation by summarizing the 2009 AACA meetings, attendees, membership numbers, AZTAN meetings, partnerships and the addition of the

Web Designer as the AACA's newest Board position. She offered Congratulations to Bryan Hill, Glendale PD, on his new book, "Fundamentals of Crime Mapping".

- Scott Peacock, AACA Vice-President, presented Sam Palmer, Phoenix PD, with the AACA 2009 Member of the Year Award. Scott read the three nominations and the association recognized each person.
- 10:00 AM: Aimee concluded her presentation and turned the meeting over to the attendees. A round-table began and each attendee introduced himself/herself and spoke for 2-3 minutes about their 2009 success stories from their respective agencies.
- 10:45 AM: Meeting concluded.



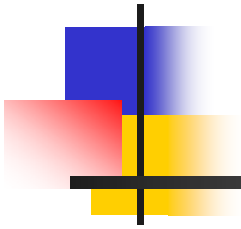






Year in Review
